

LIEUTENANT-GOVERNOR OF HIMACHAL PRADESH AND CHIEF COMMISSIONERS OF DELHI, MANIPUR AND TRIPURA TO EXERCISE POWERS AND DISCHARGE FUNCTIONS OF STATE GOVERNMENT UNDER THE WORKING JOURNALISTS (CONDITIONS OF SERVICE) AND MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS ACT, 1955.

S. R. O. 2957, dated the 13th September, 1957.—In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution, the President hereby directs that the Lieut. Governor, Himachal Pradesh, the Chief Commissioner, Delhi, the Chief Commissioner, Manipur and the Chief Commissioner, Tripura shall, subject to the control of the President and until further orders, exercise the powers and discharge the functions of the State Government under the Working Journalists (Conditions of Service) and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1955 (45 of 1955) within their respective jurisdictions.
