

AUTHENTICATION OF INSTRUMENTS IN THE NAME OF CHIEF COMMISSIONER,  
TRIPURA.

S. R. O. 3034, dated the 18th September, 1957.—In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution, and in supersession of the notification of the Government of India in the Ministry of States, No. S. R. O. 546, dated the 1st March, 1955, the President hereby directs that all orders and other instruments made and executed in the name of the Chief Commissioner of the Union territory of Tripura shall be authenticated by the signature of the Chief Secretary, a Secretary, a Deputy Secretary or an Assistant Secretary in any of the departments, or the Registrar, Civil Secretariat of the Tripura Administration.
