This is regarding my E-Mail written to Disaster Management Division of the MHA which is reproduced below for kind perusal please:

Given below is my grievance which was forwarded to the Uttar Pradesh State Disaster office on 7th July 2014 but as on date not even an acknowledgement has been received from them:

Respected Mr. Relief Commissioner and other revered authorities,
The position that I am going to hereby describe has been several times brought to the notice of all the concerned authorities at Meerut, i.e. The Secretary, Meerut Development Authority, Meerut Municipal Commissioner, the pollution control board, Pallavpuram, Meerut etc. but no action has been taken.

The disaster risk to the residents of House No. KP - 41 (Near Zonal Park) Ganga Nagar, falls well within the purview of Section 2 (d) of the Disaster Management Act 2005, where due to operation of illegal dairies in House No. KP - 42 and surrounding places compounded by the fact that no proper sewerage system exists, which is the obligation of the State Authorities, the accumulation of silt, cow dung and choked nallis has reached an alarming position. The position has worsened as immensely dirty water filled with polluted material overflows and becomes stagnant in the vacant plots besides the house. This becomes a haven for all types of deadly animals like snakes etc. besides mosquitoes and breeding of pigs. The position has been continuing for the past couple of years making it extremely dangerous for the residents of KP - 41 (Near Zonal Park) Ganga Nagar to live owing to the morbid stench emanating 24/7 and also due to the fact that the choked nallis could anytime lead to weakening of the foundations of the house No. KP - 41 (Near Zonal Park) Ganga Nagar, Meerut. Sir, the disaster risk that I as the owner of House No. KP - 41 (Near

Zonal Park), Ganga Nagar, Meerut am facing due to the operation of unauthorized dairies mainly in KP - 42 Ganga Nagar, Meerut and surrounding places and the apathy and lackluster attitude of the Government authorities towards either stopping them or create a powerful waste drainage system, could anytime lead to a catastrophe, mishap, calamity or grave occurrence in the area, arising from man-made causes and due to gross negligence of the government authorities. This would almost inevitably lead to substantial loss of life or human suffering or damage to, and destruction of, property, or damage to, or degradation of, environment or magnitude beyond the coping capacity of the community of the affected area.

I therefore request that in view of the position brought out above, immediate disaster prevention steps may be taken under intimation to me please.
