

Our Military, Para Military and CPO have been involved in CI operation for long. These forces operate in disturbed areas under Armed Forces Special Powers Act. My request for information pertains to certain issues as asked below.

- (4) How many terrorists since 2000 have been charged, convicted and punished (sentence awarded) for murdering the soldiers in CI Operations? Please provide information forces wise?
