CHIEF COMMISSIONER, ANDAMAN AND NICOBAR ISLANDS TO EXERCISE THE POWERS OF A STATE GOVERNMENT UNDER CERTAIN SECTIONS OF THE ANDAMAN AND NICOBAR ISLANDS REGULATION, 1876.

S. R. O. 348, dated the 8th March, 1951.—In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of article 243 of the Constitution, the President hereby directs that the Chief Commissioner, Andaman and Nicobar Islands, shall, subject to the control of the President, exercise the powers of a State Government under sections 15, 16, sub-section (1) of section 17A, sections 19, 19B, 20, 21, 24, 31 and 33 of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands Regulation, 1876 (Regulation III of 1876).
