CHIEF COMMISSIONER OF VINDHYA PRADESH TO EXERCISE THE POWERS AND DISCHARGE THE FUNCTIONS OF THE CENTRAL GOVERNMENT UNDER CERTAIN SECTIONS OF THE INDIAN POWER ALCOHOL ACT, 1948.

S.R.O. 545, dated the 12th April, 1951.—In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution, the President hereby directs that the Chief Commissioner of Vindhya Pradesh shall, subject to the control of the President and until further orders, exercise the powers and discharge the functions of the Central Government under the provisions of sections 5, 6 and 10 of the Indian Power Alcohol Act, 1948 (XXII of 1948) in the State of Vindhya Pradesh.
