Sir,

I am directed to say that freedom fighters' pension is being granted from the Central Revenues to those persons whose claims are covered under the provisions of Swatantrata Sainik Samman Pension Scheme. In certain cases the Samman Pension has been granted to both husband and wife separately on their being covered by the aforesaid Scheme individually. According to recent instructions contained in this Ministry's letter No. 8/17/89-FF(P) dated 1.5.92 the procedure for transfer of pension in the name of the spouse consequent to death of freedom fighter was decentralized by empowering the pension disbursing authorities to transfer pension in the name of spouse on completion of certain formalities.

2. In this connection, it is clarified that in cases where both husband and wife are drawing freedom fighters' pension from Central Revenues individually the Samman Pension should not be transferred in the name of the spouse consequent to the death of either of them. It is, requested that the above position may be brought to the notice of all concerned.
