Subject: - Transfer of residuary items of work/assets in the Settlement Wing to the Govt. of Rajasthan.

Sir,

I am directed to say that the question of administration, management and disposal of the remaining undisposed of acquired evacuee urban properties, rural properties, recovery of balance cost of land and issue of Sanads in respect of the land claim allottees of Alwar and Bharatpur districts, litigation work etc. has been under consideration of the Government of India for some time past.

It has transpired that only a limited number of acquired evacuee urban properties and rural properties remain to be disposed of. Besides, the work relating to the recovery of the balance cost of lands allotted in Alwar and Bharatpur districts and the issue of Sanads to the persons concerned, can be more expeditiously dealt with by the State Government. I m accordingly, to convey the sanction of the President to the transfer of the following items of residuary assets/work relating to the administration, management and disposal of the properties etc. to the State Government on the terms and conditions indicated against each:

tine Set (Lement (i) Urban acquired evacuee properties.

The number of such properties in Rajasthan is 60 as per details given in Annexure-I attached. The valuation of 57 properties out of the total number of 60 has been indicated therein viz. Rs. 58,964/-. The remaining 3 properties would be evaluated by the State Government. The State Government would pay to the Government of India 15% of the sale proceeds of the 60 properties being transferred to them and retain the balance 85 per cent.

There are 1237 cases of land allo tment in Alwar and Bharatpur districts. The pending work involves recovery of balance cost from the allottees and issue of Sanads in cases where full cost has been recovered. On the pattern of Sri-ganganagar lands, the State Government would pay 50 per cent of the realisations made by them towards the balance cost of the land and the remaining 50 per cent would be retained by them. 17th June, 1980.

(iv) Transfer of littleation work connected with High Court/Civil Courts.

The State Government shall take over from the Government of India the work relating to the cases pertaining to the properties included in the compensation pool in the State of Rajasthan in respect of litigation matters pending in the High Court and Civil Courts. the Govt, of Rajasthan, matters pending in the High Court and CIVII Courts.
They will not claim any re-imbursement of expenditure on account of establishment charges and fees of the counsels. The properties mentioned above and the work relating to the recovery of the balance cost of lands issue of Sanads, litigation work etc. shall be deemed to have been completely transferred to the State Government with effect from 1.7.1980. Accordingly, the sale proceeds of the properties and other dues will become payable by the State Government on that date and shall be paid in six-annual half yearly equal instalments without payment of any interest. The first half yearly instalment due on 1.7.1980, shall be paid by 31.3.1981 and subsequently half yearly instalments will be computed from that date. The total amount payable by the State Government in this respect will be worked out and intimated to them by the Deputy Chief Settlement Commissioner(G), Settlement Wing, New Delhi.
