Narcotics Control Bureau -

The Narcotics Control Bureau is the national nodal agency under the Ministry of Home Affairs created under the Narcotics Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 for combating illicit trafficking in narcotic drugs and psychotropic substances. NCB is also responsible for coordination with various ministries, other offices & State/Central enforcement agencies. The NCB is also responsible for implementation of the international obligations under various UN Conventions 1961, 1971, 1988 (to which India is signatory) against illicit trafficking of drugs. It also provides required assistance to concerned authorities of various countries to facilitate universal action for prevention and suppression of illicit trafficking in narcotics drugs and psychotropic substances.
