## Subject:-: MINUSTAH: Deployment of SAAT Qualified Police Officers against Rotational Vacancies.

The undersigned is directed to refer to PMI to UN vide their E/Fax No. 111 dated 17<sup>th</sup> August, 2016 intimating that Ms Amla Mary, Mr. Binod Kumar Singh and Ms Manju Sharma have not been considered for deployment in the mission presently, as their expertise are not required in MINUSTAH. It was further intimated that remaining five (05) officers will be deployed as soon as their medical clearance is completed. The details of remaining police officers are as under:-

In this context, it is submitted that this Ministry has nominated only two lady police officers i.e. Ms Amla Mary, ASI, Delhi Police and Ms Manju Sharma, Inspector, Chandigharh Police alongwith other 14 male police officers. All the remaining 04 police officers including 02 lady police officers fulfills the requisite criterion as per job matrix earmarked by UN SAAT for deployment to MINUSTAH. Moreover, they are having previous UN/International experience. As per UN Mandate, equal preferences to be given to female candidates for UN Missions. As non-consideration may affect the overall morale of lady police officers.

In view of the above PMI to UN to take-up the matter with UNDPKO to re-consider the case of Ms Amla Mary, ASI, Delhi Police and Ms Manju Sharma, Inspector, Chandigharh Police, Mr. Binod Kumar Singh, Inspector, Delhi Police and to issue their deployment order to MINUSTAH at the earliest alongwith Shri Dhananjay Ramchandra Kulkarni, DCP, Maharashtra Police who has been left out from the list.
