Sub : **PAR Guidelines – Removal of discrepancies**

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the DoPT O.M. No. 11059/07/2008-AIS.III dated 26.06.2008 prescribing the guidelines for forwarding of PARs in respect of IPS officers by the State Governments/UTs. In the said guidelines it has been, *inter-alia*, prescribed that one set of complete PAR in respect of an IPS officer is required to be forwarded to the Nodal Officer in the Central Government, i.e. Joint Secretary (Police-I), Ministry of Home Affairs by the State Administrative Division/Department.

2. In this regard it is stated that it has come to the Ministry's noticed that a sufficient number of PARs are found not in original and/or unsigned by the respective authority(ies)/officer and which can't be taken into the respective dossier.

3. The State Governments/UTs are, therefore, requested that before forwarding PARs/NICs in respect of an IPS officer it may be ensured that the said document(s) is/are in original and complete in every respect.
