Sir,

I am directed to refer to this Ministry's letter of even number dated 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2014 and 11<sup>th</sup> June 2014 on the above subject and to say that PMI to UN vide their E/Fax No. 162 dated 16<sup>th</sup> September, 2014 (copy enclosed) has confirmed the selection of following 03 (three) Police Officers for their deployment to UNFICYP (Cyprus) on 17<sup>th</sup> October 2014:-

2. Above officers may be relieved to report to the Commandant, National UN CIVPOL Centre, ITBP, Opposite Batra Hospital, New Delhi by 9<sup>th</sup> October 2014 alongwith their Official Passport to complete the travel formalities:-

3. The detailed instruction for the deployment are as under :-

- **CASH** : Police officers must bring sufficient cash (USD) to sustain one (1) week during the induction in Cyprus ( USD \$ 100 per day).
- **Vaccination Certificate** – Yellow Fever vaccination is mandatory and proof of immunisation must be produced at entry for all travellers.
- **Malaria**: Malaria Prophylaxis is required as per UN guidelines.
- The United Nations Travel Unit will issue travel authorisation (TA) for the selected officers alongwith "To whom it may concern letter", which should be displayed by the officers to the border/immigration authorities of the host country upon arrival.

- **In-Mission Driving test** – The selected police officers must have at least two years of recent driving experience, and must be in possession of valid National or International civilian driving licences. Police Officers must present their valid national driving licenses upon arrival in in the mission area. The license should be valid during their service. They are subject to in-mission assessment in driving skills. If fails, they will be repatriated at their own expense.
- **Medical examination:** pre-deployment medical examination is required to be completed in accordance with the guidelines for the UN Police Officers on assignment with Peace Keeping Missions
- The original receipt certifying depositing of personal passport with the issuing authority in case of any passport held earlier.

6. The candidates are also advised to furnish the following documents on reporting to the Commandant, National UN CIVPOL Centre:-

6. NOC and relieving order from their Home Department at the time of reporting at National UN CIVPOL Centre.

(ii) Recommended clothing & equipment required for UNFICYP.

5. The UN only pays subsistence allowance during the period of deployment within UN Mission area. **The pay and allowances are to be paid by the lending authority. The officers may also be allowed to retain Government accommodation/telephone etc., if any held by them.**

6. It must be ensured that the above police officers have rendered 08 years of police service including training period and are clear from vigilance angle. They have to compulsorily get the uniform and bear the cost of uniform from their personal saving. They are entitled to carry 100 Kg. total baggage's, including hand/Cabin baggage.





1. We are pleased to inform you that three police officers from India nominated for secondment to United Nations Peacekeeping Force in Cyprus (UNFICYP) have been selected (as per attached Deployment Tracking "UNFICYP-PD-16-Sep-14--03 India"). The scheduled date of their departure from Ireland is **17 October 2014**. We would appreciate your kind assistance in expediting the release of the above mentioned officer for secondment and passing the necessary internal administrative formalities. The remaining five officers are still pending medical clearance and they will be deployed after they are medically cleared in due course.
2. The United Nations Travel Unit will issue travel authorization (TA) for the selected officers along with "To whom it may concern" letter, which should be displayed by the officers to the border/immigration authorities of the host country upon arrival.
3. Please be advised that a pre-deployment medical examination is required to be completed in accordance with the "Guidelines for UN police officers on assignment with Peacekeeping Operations". The completed original MS-2 forms must be forwarded to the Police Division before actual deployment to the Mission. **The officers will not travel to the Mission until the MS-2 forms are submitted to the Police Division.**
4. Police Division deems necessary to remind that the selected police officers must have at least two years of recent driving experience, and must be in possession of valid national or international civilian driving licenses. Police officers must present their valid national driving licences upon arrival in the mission area. The license should be valid during their service.
5. The Police Division wishes to remind the Permanent Mission that incoming police officers are subject to in-mission assessment in English language, driving skills and, where applicable, weapon handling and shooting, if they have not been cleared by a UN SAAT team. Please be advised that if any of them fails such assessments he/she will be repatriated at the expense of the national Government. Alternately, if he/she had successfully passed SAAT tests



earlier, only his/her driving skills will be re-examined. The officers, who return to the mission area within the 24-month period after their departure from that or other mission with similar conditions of service and working language, are considered as those SAAT cleared.

6. I would like to convey to you my appreciation for your country's continued efforts to contribute highly skilled and well trained and equipped police officer to the United Nations.
