I am directed to refer to the subject mentioned above and to say that DGsP/IGsP Conference, 2021 held in November at Lucknow. Some recommendations made in the Conference relates to police stations in border areas. These recommendations are as under:-

No. 22 – “In border areas, block/PSs should be defined and demarcated on basis of geographical locations instead of population density.”

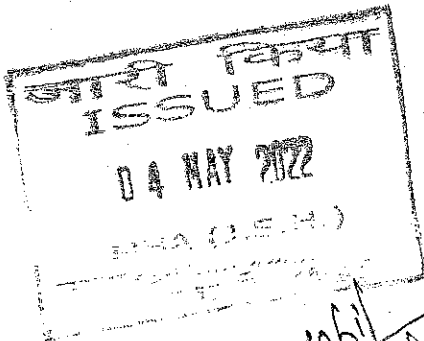
No. 55 – “All States should review the number of Police Stations in border areas and set up new PSs. States should also coordinate with IB and other Central agencies on border issues.”
