QUALITATIVE REQUIREMENTS FOR TELESCOPIC BLACK JACK (BATON)

- 1. It should be compact & slim.
- 2. Dimension: -
 - (i) Length Extended length 26" (+ or 10%) and retracted maximum 10 inch.
 - (ii) Dia. Maximum 1.5 inch.
- 3. Should be light, maximum weight not to exceed 0.5 kg.
- ✓ 4. It must have a safety locking mechanism to keep extended/retracted baton in place.
 - 5. It must have a rubber grip on handle and a wrist strap.
 - 6. The body must be made of non corrosive metal alloy.
 - 7. It should be non reflective and rust resistant.
 - 8. It must be provided with a leather holster with straps for carriage.
 - 9. Minimum one piece is required for evaluation.
