



## Ultra Violet Desktop/ Fake currency Detector

Sl. No	Specifications
1.	It should be based on Ultra-Violet Technology. It should have UV Tube and components.
2.	It should be capable to detect all type of fake currency including Indian currency.
3.	It should have magnifier to check micro-printing
4.	User should not be exposed to UV Rays . It should have anti-radiation shield
5.	It should be easy to operate and maintain.
6.	Its size should not be more than 40 (L)cm x 20 (D) cm x 20 (H) cm +/- 10 %
7.	Weight- 5 Kg max
8.	Power consumption – Not more than 12 W
9.	Power source- 210-230 VAC




