2. This invitation is for nomination of the qualified Formed Police Unit(FPU) Training Police Officers to participate in the sixth edition of the Training-of-Trainers (ToT) course that is being planned from 26th July to 17 September, 2021 (eight weeks) at Turkish National Academy in Ankara, Turkey to be conducted by the integrated Training Service (ITS), Police Division of Department of Peace Operations in cooperation with the Government to Turkey.

3. The Objective along with the requisite eligibility criteria and Financial conditions for mentioned course are enclosed/attached with this letter for information. The costs, if any, associated with the participants/travel or others, it will be borne by the concerned nominated department/force.

Therefore, it is requested that nomination of FPU Police Training officers who are engaged in delivering UN pre-deployment training for Police personnel of rank of Inspector to Commandant level may be submitted through proper channel to this Ministry by 01st June, 2021 alongwith the following mandatory documents duly completed in all respect and be sent through electronic mail to police2-un@mha.gov.in in pdf format only before the last date:-




1. The Police Division, Office of Rule of Law and Security Institutions, United Nations Department of Peace Operations presents its compliments to the Permanent Mission of the Member States/PCCs contributing FPUs/police personnel to the United Nations and has the honour to refer to its UN Standardized FPU Training-of-Trainers (ToT) Course.
2. In order to assist Police Contributing Countries (PCCs) with relevant training materials, develop and enhance their capacity to deliver training, thus ensuring operational readiness of the FPUs prior to their deployment and also to enhance the performance of the deployed FPUs, the Police Division of DPO/OROLSI, together with the Integrated Training Services ITS/DPO, and in consultation with experts from relevant PCCs, has developed an United Nations Standardized Pre-deployment Training Curriculum to prepare FPU personnel for their future deployment to UN Peace Operations.
3. Consequently, this curriculum is delivered to the Member States contributing FPUs through regional Training-of-Trainers (ToT) courses. Five of such activities were successfully conducted in the past, namely in Moscow-Russia on April 2009; at Gaborone-India in November 2011; Gaborone-Botswana, in February 2012; Amman-Jordan, in July 2015; and the last one held in Yaounde-Cameroon, on June 2016.
4. Following the above practice, the Police Division is pleased to inform the Permanent Mission of Member States contributing police personnel to Peace Operations that, availing the support offered from the Government of Turkey, is planning to organize the "6th International ToT Course for FPU trainers", to increase the pool of certified FPU trainers.
5. The sixth edition of the ToT course is being planned from 26 July to 17 September 2021 (eight weeks) and will take place at the Turkish National Police Academy located in Ankara, Turkey.

6. On this regard, the Permanent Missions of Police Contributing Countries are invited to nominate up to three (03) qualified candidates, to participate in the forthcoming ToT as trainees. The Police Division will screen the CVs of all proposed candidates and select the most suitable, to participate in the course.
7. The proposed candidates should be police officers (from Lieutenant to Major, or equivalent police rank) on active police service, who are qualified FPU training officers and will continue serving in that function in the future; or who will be considered for future deployment as FPU Training Staff during the upcoming FPU rotations; or considered for future deployment to serve as individual police officers (IPO), with UN peace operations.
8. The Police Division would like to stress the importance that all the nominated participants must speak English fluently as this ToT course will be organised entirely in English language. The participants will have to interact extensively during the Course.
9. The Turkish government will be covering all the expenses related to internal transportation, accommodation and meals during the course, within the facility of the Ankara Police Academy. We would however appreciate if your government could cover the costs associated with the international travel, of your respective participants.
10. Some limited donor funding is available to support international travel, which could be provided to selected Member States, upon their requests. In case your government requests the support for covering the travel costs of participants, please indicate that, along with your response.
11. The list of nominated candidates should be submitted using the enclosed Forms (see Annex 1) along with completed CV for each candidate using the standard enclosed EASP format (see Annex 2). For your convenience, all these forms will be sent to your mission in electronic version via e-mail.
12. Nominations should be submitted to the Selection & Recruitment Section of UN Police Division (UNHQ - DC-1, 7th floor, room 706) **by COB 06 June 2021**. Please note that nominations received after this date will not be considered.
