

1. The United Nations Police Training Architecture Programme, launched in April 2019, is a joint effort undertaken by DPO's Police Division and DPET Integrated Training Service, in close cooperation with the United Nations Member States as well as selected United Nations Agencies, Funds and Programmes. This programme aims to enhance the performance of the UNPOL officers deployed in United Nations peace operations across the globe by providing police-contributing countries with standardized pre-deployment and job-specific training materials, thereby enabling them to deliver quality and relevant training to the seconded uniformed personnel.
2. The work of the initial six Curriculum Development Groups (CDGs) is now drawing to a close with the curricula being finalized. Building on the success of the initial stage of the Programme, the Police Division and Integrated Training Service would like to convene a new CDG on Border Management to develop training materials relevant to UNPOL officers working on this issue in the field.
3. With this aim in mind, we kindly request Member States to nominate police experts on Border Management – ideally with a curriculum development and/or training background – to participate in the inaugural meeting of the CDG to be held in Madrid, Spain, from 8-10 February 2022. The meeting will use the draft United Nations Border Management Manual to initiate the development of job-specific training modules in this area.

4. Member States are requested to cover all the costs associated with the participation in the event. However, some limited funding support is available, if needed. If a Member State wishes to seek sponsorship to join the workshop, it is requested to indicate this in the cover note from its Permanent Mission to the United Nations. We would like to draw your attention to the fact that we may need to prioritize the sponsorship due to available funds.
5. Please provide your nominations by sending the names of the experts, together with their completed EASP form, to Mr. Denis Tikhomirov (tikhomirovd@un.org) no later than 10 December 2021.
