5. **No modified format other than the specimen enclosed duly typed will be entertained/accepted as it invites lot of observations from UN HQ (UNDPKO) while finalizing the nominations.** Hand written registration form will not be entertained/accepted. It may be ensured that the photograph of the officers applying should be placed on EAC..
6. It may please be ensured that the nominees are **clear from Vigilance angle and Necessary Cadre Clearance (for all Officers) from MHA/State Government/CAPFs/any other lending organization must be forwarded with nomination.** (without cadre clearance and NOC from parent cadre, nominations will not be entertained).
7. **No direct application will be entertained.** Applications through proper channel only i.e. through Home Department(State)/approval of Head of Organization will be entertained. Applications received after the deadline specified will not be accepted. All Costs associated with participating in the Course (airfare, meals and accommodation) will be borne by United Nations.
8. All the officers may be advised not to make any direct contact with UNHQ authority. Nomination through MHA only will be considered.

1. The Information and Communications Technology Division (ICTD) of the Department of Field Support (DFS) has the pleasure to refer to Note Verbale DFS/ICTD/206/0343 dated 17 May 2016 regarding the UN Signals Academy Women's Outreach Course. We wish to inform Member States about the hosting of the upcoming fifth edition of the Course, scheduled to take place from 15 October to 2 November 2018 in Entebbe, Uganda.
2. The Women's Outreach Course is a specialized training programme for women military and police information and communications technology (ICT) specialists. The programme is a direct response to Security Council Resolution 2122 (2013), which encourages troops and police-contributing countries to increase the percentage of women military and police in deployments to UN peacekeeping operations and address gender imbalance.
3. In this regard, Member States are encouraged to register women military officers who will undergo the Course in the Peacekeeping Capability Readiness System.
4. The Course is three weeks in duration and is conducted in English. It is aimed to prepare military staff officers to be deployed in UN peacekeeping operations as signals experts in a Force or Sector Headquarters (J/G6) and police officers as advisors to police commissioners on ICT matters.
5. Training content covers the necessary knowledge and skills relating to command, control, communications' operations, planning systems as well as relevant UN policies, regulations and standard operating procedures required to provide participants with the background needed to

prepare for deployment.

6. All costs associated with participating in the Course (airfare, meals, and accommodation), will be sponsored by the United Nations, enabled by the generous donation of the Government of Japan.

7. Participants must have valid international health insurance coverage while attending the course. The provision of health insurance is a national responsibility.

8. Participants who do not arrive on the first day of the training for circumstances other than unforeseen flight delays will not be accepted later than the second day of the course. Costs associated with late arrival (airfare, meals, and accommodations) will be the responsibility of the participant country.

9. The United Nations kindly invites the Permanent Missions to nominate qualified women candidates with the following profile requirements:

Military

- Women military specialized in operating ICT systems

- Rank: Captain and above

- Language: Fluency in English

Police

- Women police specialized in technical support for ICT

- Rank: Assistant Superintendent and above

- Language: Fluency in English
