Subject: Policy guidelines for deputation of combatised CAPFs and AR personnel in other organization – reg.

The undersigned is directed to invited attention to the policy guidelines dated 22.11.2016 and 15.12.2016 on the subject mentioned above and to say that after issue of the said policy guidelines, some Forces (CAPFs/AR) have sent individual cases of officers who are on deputation to Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB) and National Investigating Agency (NIA) prior to issue of the said guidelines, to the Ministry for seeking extension of their deputation period as per the deputation policy dated 22nd November, 2016. Further clarifications are also being sought by the CAPFs/AR as to whether the officers already on deputation to NCB/NIA and whose initial period of deputation was three years would be automatically eligible for extension of deputation tenure for 7 years or they would have to seek extension from the Ministry in this regard.

- 2. The matter has been considered and it has been decided that in order to save time and unnecessary correspondence for extending the deputation period of officers already on deputation to NCB/NIA prior to issue of policy guidelines dated 22nd November, 2016, on case to case basis, the period of deputation in respect of such officers would automatically stand revised 7 years in NCB/NIA and their cases need not be referred to this Ministry for seeking extension. However, their total tenure would not extend beyond 07 years.
- 3. This issues with the approval of the competent authority.
