
NOTIFICATION

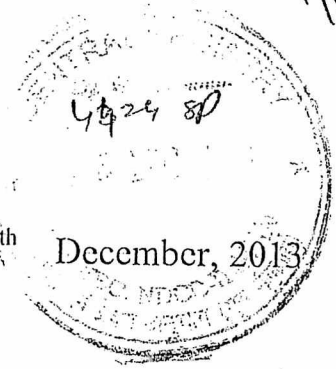



2. Director General of Police, Tripura may immediately inform all the security agencies accordingly.


