Permanent Mission of India to the United Nations (PMI to UN) has informed about the invitation received from the Integrated Training Service of UN for the training courses being conducted by the Brazilian Peace Operations Joint Training Centre (CCOPAB) in 2024.

2. The Brazilian Peace Operations Joint Training Centre (CCOPAB) is conducting the following courses in 2024 which are open to international participants.

3. The course(s) are being conducted by the Brazilian Peace Operations Joint Training Centre (CCOPAB). The aim of the course is to prepare the participants for deployment in UN Peace operations. **No fixed slot from India is available. It is an open invitation for all members' states of UN.** The candidates should have a broad experience of police service, and are selected to serve as a police officer in an international peace support operation. The recommended nominees by Government of India will be selected by the General Staff of the Brazilian Army. The selection process considers a balance in professional and organizational backgrounds.

4. The Government of Brazil will provide airline tickets, meals and accommodation and the training center (CCOPAB) will provide internal transport, including airport pickup and drop.



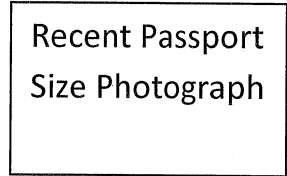
Requisite requirements

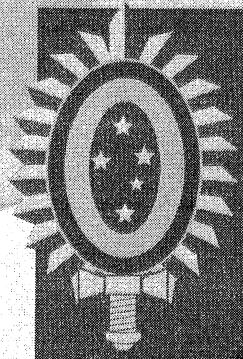

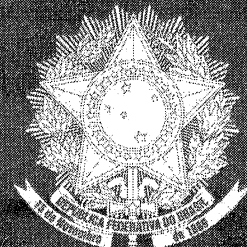

NATIONAL INVESTIGATION OFFICER COURSE

19th August to 13th September 2024.

1. Course Description

The objective of the National Investigation Officer Course is to train National Investigation Officers (NIOs) to be knowledgeable to undertake investigations in the field in response to allegations of serious misconduct. The role of the NIO is to undertake impartial investigations into serious misconduct allegations to determine if an allegation of misconduct is substantiated.

2. Requirements for Participation

- Two vacancies will be offered.

To be eligible to attend the course, nominees must fulfill the following criteria:

- Rank level: Sergeant (OR-5) to Lieutenant Colonel (OF-4) or equivalent.
- Course will be taught in Portuguese and English.

3. Selection Criteria

Nominees will be selected by the General Staff of the Brazilian Army. The selection process considers a balance in professional and organizational backgrounds.

4. Course Cost

According to the agreement between the Brazilian Ministry of Defense and the United Nations, the Government of Brazil will provide airline tickets, meals and accommodation for the selected foreign trainees. The Brazilian Peace Operations Joint Training Center (acronym CCOPAB, in Portuguese) will provide transportation, within Brazil, for all planned activities, including reception/departure arrangements. Reception and transfer from the airport to the CCOPAB premises will be arranged according to the respective flight's itineraries.

5. Courses Dates

The following dates will be applied to the course:

- a) E-learning phase: **from 19th to 30th August 2024.**

b) On site phase: **from 2nd to 13th September 2024.**

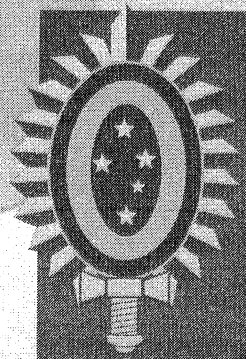

1. Course Description

The objective of the UN Protection of Civilians Course (UN POC Course) is to provide specific guidance to military and police personnel on the context of UN peacekeeping missions mandated to protect civilians from an array of threats found in the field, following the UN Specialized Training Material on POC, combining conceptual, legal and operational frameworks. It further seeks to give them the necessary knowledge about: the UN Core Pre-Deployment Training Materials (UN CPTM); the composition, organization, main features, key roles, capacities, capabilities and limitations according to UN POC STM.

2. Requirements for Participation

To be eligible to attend the course, nominees must fulfill the following criteria:

- Rank level: Sergeant (OR-5) to Lieutenant Colonel (OF-4) or equivalent.
- Required experience (if applicable): Be working in, or about to be deployed to a conflict area in a UN Peace Mission.
- Course will be taught in English.

3. Selection Criteria

Nominees will be selected by the Ministry of Defense of Brazil. The selection process considers a balance in professional and organizational backgrounds.

4. Course Cost

According to the agreement between the Brazilian Ministry of Defense and the United Nations, the Government of Brazil will provide airline tickets, meals and accommodation for the selected foreign trainees. The Brazilian Peace Operations Joint Training Center (acronym CCOPAB, in Portuguese) will provide transportation, within Brazil, for all planned activities, including reception/departure arrangements. Reception and transfer from the airport to the CCOPAB premises will be arranged according to the respective flight's itineraries.
