**RE: Declaring 'Sikhs for Justice (SFJ)' as an "unlawful association" under sub-section (1) and (3) of Section 3 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 (37 of 1967) - Extension thereof for a further period of five years {notification bearing No. S.O. 2660 (E) dated 8<sup>th</sup> July, 2024, published in the Gazette of India: Extraordinary, Part II, Section 3(ii), on 09<sup>th</sup> July, 2024}**

To,

**'Sikhs for Justice' (SFJ)**

**WHEREAS** the Central Government in exercise of powers conferred by sub-sections (1) and (3) of Section 3 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 (hereinafter referred to as the 'Act'), vide notification bearing **No. S.O. 2660 (E) dated 8<sup>th</sup> July, 2024**, published in the Gazette of India: Extraordinary, Part II, Section 3(ii), on 09<sup>th</sup> July, 2024, for the reasons and grounds stated therein has extended the declaration of the **'Sikhs for Justice'** (in short **'SFJ'**), as an "Unlawful Association", for a further period of five years from 10<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2024.

**AND WHEREAS** vide Gazette Notification bearing **No. S.O. 3097 (E) dated 2<sup>nd</sup> August, 2024** published in the Gazette of India: Extraordinary, Part II, Section 3(ii), in exercise of powers conferred under sub-section (1) of Section 5 of the Act, the Central Government has constituted a Tribunal comprising **Justice Anoop Kumar Mendiratta, Judge, High Court of Delhi**, for the




purpose of adjudicating, whether or not there is sufficient cause for extending the declaration of **'Sikhs for Justice (SFJ)'**, as an "Unlawful Association" within the ambit of the Act.

NOW THEREFORE, Notice is hereby given to you under sub-section (2) of Section 4 of the Act, to show cause in writing within 30 days from the date of service of the Notice, why the Association namely **'Sikhs for Justice (SFJ)'**, should not be declared as unlawful and why order should not be made confirming the declaration made in the above-mentioned Notification.

The objections/reply/written statement, if any, may be filed/delivered, within the statutory period of 30 days from the date of service of the Notice, with the undersigned at his office at **Chamber No. 15, Ground Floor, 'A' Block, Delhi High Court, Sher Shah Road, New Delhi- 110503**. In case the objections/reply and documents are in regional language, true English Translation thereof be also attached.

You may appear before the Tribunal on **26.09.2024 at 2:30 PM** in the Delhi High Court, Sher Shah Road, New Delhi – 110503 for further proceedings. Appearance may also be made through a duly authorized and instructed Counsel/Advocate.
