Subject: Fifty-Second Report on 'National Policy on Child Labour - An Assessment' of the Standing committee on Labour, Textiles and Skill Development (SCOL), Lok Sabha - Observations - Advisory on elimination of child labour- regarding

Sir/Madam

I am directed to request your attention towards the Fifty-Second Report on 'National Policy on Child Labour - An Assessment' of the Standing Committee on Labour, Textiles and Skill Development, (Lok Sabha), whereby the Standing Committee has observed that despite the stringent measures in the Child and Adolescent Labour (Prohibition and Regulation) Act, 1986, and the Rules made thereunder, the scourge of child labour still exists in a significant way. The Standing Committee has further observed that FIRs in child labour cases are not being lodged as they should be. The number of cases registered under the Act imply that the implementation of the existing laws is not strictly enforced.

2. The Government of India attaches the highest importance to matters relating to the safety of children, and therefore the Union Government has been advising the State Governments/UT Administrations from time to time to effectively deal with crimes against children. The issue of child labour remains a significant concern that requires urgent and comprehensive action by all relevant authorities. The Government of India is deeply concerned with the instances of child labour and would therefore emphasize that urgent action should be taken by the State Governments and UT Administrations on the following:-

- i. Government/Administration must ensure vigorous and conscientious enforcement of the statutory provisions and existing law pertaining to child labour. The administration and police should play a more proactive role in detection and reporting of cases of child labour and ensuring that FIRs are lodged properly in all cases of child labour, without any leniency.
- ii. Government/Administration may assign the responsibility of reporting instances of children selling goods or begging at traffic lights to the Traffic Police and they may also be held accountable for not reporting such instances.
- iii. Government/Administration should facilitate better coordination between various law-enforcing agencies and other stakeholders including NGOs, Child Welfare Committee (CWC), Anti-Human Trafficking Unit (AHTU), District Child Protection Unit (DCPU), District Legal Service Authority (DLSA), Railway Protection Force (RPF) / Government Railway Police, Labour Inspectors, Factories inspectors, RDO / Deputy Collector, Child Welfare Police Officers and central armed forces etc.



- iv. Government/Administration must sensitize the law enforcement machinery and other stake holders about the gravity of the crime of child labour by way of well-structured training programmes, meetings, conferences, workshops, seminars, awareness programs etc. highlighting the commitment of Government to eliminate child labour and the detrimental impact it has on the children concerned and on the economic & social development of the nation.
- v. Government/Administration may take steps to disseminate awareness and sensitize the communities including various Market Associations / Resident Welfare Associations and other local bodies about the consequences of deploying child labour at commercial/residential places etc. through launch of massive awareness campaigns utilizing all possible means viz. print, electronic and social media platforms and encourage the communities to report such cases.
- vi. Government/Administration should have budgetary allocations for the child labour related activities besides integrating 'Child Budgeting' into all the budgets and programmes of the State Governments and their Undertakings, optimum utilization of the budget allocated for children should also be ensured while periodically increasing the allocation, keeping in mind evolving needs.

3. The social evil of child labour perpetuates the exploitation and suffering of children depriving them of meaningful education, training opportunities and all possible avenues of development, thereby also hampering the nation's social & economic progress. It is crucial to recognise that elimination of child labour requires concerted & coordinated efforts from all levels of governance as well as active participation of society and community stakeholders. It is therefore requested to take proactive steps for implementation of above-mentioned recommendations to tackle child labour and leverage all possible means and measures for detection, rehabilitation and prevention of child labour.

4. You are requested to kindly issue suitable directions to all concerned under intimation to this Ministry.
