I am directed to refer to this Ministry's letter of even number dated **28.08.2025** regarding nomination of police officers from the UNSAAT Panel 2024-26 for deployment to the United Nations Mission in South Sudan (UNMISS) and the **Deployment Authorization (copy enclosed)** received from the Permanent Mission of India to the United Nations and UN Police Division, UNHQ on the above-mentioned subject and to inform that the UN Police Division, through PMI, has conveyed deployment authorization in respect of the following officers as Individual Police Officers (IPOs) for the **proposed deployment on 26th September, 2026** to UNMISS (South Sudan):

2. The UN Police Division has confirmed the selection of all the above 16 officers for deployment to UNMISS (South Sudan), with 26th September, 2026 as the expected date of deployment. The final travel date and itinerary, however, shall be subject to the operational requirements of the Mission, flight availability and completion of necessary travel arrangements by the United Nations. The UNMISS/RSCE Travel Unit at Entebbe will communicate the e-tickets, Travel Authorizations and other relevant travel documents to the concerned officers in due course.

3. The concerned officers may be advised to strictly comply with the instructions/guidelines contained in Annexure-I and the Deployment Authorization (copy enclosed) issued by the UN Police Division.

4. The UN only pays subsistence allowance during the period of deployment within UN Mission area. The pay and allowances are to be paid by the lending authority. The officers may also be allowed to retain Government accommodation/telephone etc., if any held by them.

5. The officers may also be advised to strictly comply with any further instructions issued by the UNMISS/RSCE Travel Unit, UNMISS Human Resources Management Unit and other concerned UN authorities and after completion of their deployment they must report at UNCIVPOL centre.

6. It is, therefore, requested that the above police officers may be relieved to report at the National UN CIVPOL Centre, 22nd Battalion ITBP, Tigri, Madangir, New Delhi, on/before **16.09.2026**, so as to enable them to complete the necessary formalities well in advance of the proposed deployment to UNMISS on 26.09.2026.
