CHIEF COMMISSIONERS OF KUTCH, BHOPAL, VINDHYA PRADESH, TRIPURA AND MANIPUR STATES TO DISCHARGE THE FUNCTIONS OF A STATE GOVERNMENT UNDER THE DENTISTS ACT, 1948.

S.R.O. 1050, dated the 5th July, 1951.—In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution, the President hereby directs that the Chief Commissioners of Kutch, Bhopal, Vindhya Pradesh, Tripura and Manipur, States shall discharge in their respective States the functions of a State Government under the Dentists Act, 1948 (XVI of 1948).
