

GOVERNMENT OF ORISSA TO DISCHARGE THE FUNCTIONS OF THE CENTRAL GOVERNMENT UNDER THE INDIAN TRADE UNIONS ACT, 1926, IN RELATION TO TRADE UNIONS, WHOSE OBJECTS ARE NOT CONFINED TO, AND WHOSE HEAD OFFICE IS SITUATED IN, THAT STATE.

S. R. O. 1301, dated the 14th August, 1951.—In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of article 258 of the Constitution of India, and in supersession of the notification of the Government of India in the late Department of Labour, No. L. 3006, dated the 16th January, 1941 in so far as it applies to the State of Orissa, the President hereby with effect from the 15th August, 1951 entrusts to the Government of Orissa, with its consent, the functions of the Central Government under the Indian Trade Unions Act, 1926 (XVI of 1926), in relation to trade unions whose objects are not confined to, and whose head office is situated in, that State.
