Sir,

I am directed to refer to your above mentioned RTI application (Received in this Section on 12.11.2013) under Right to Information Act, 2005.

2. As regards point 1 : As per the present Constitutional arrangement, the 'Police' and 'Public Order' in Delhi are reserved subjects. As such, Delhi Police falls directly under the control of Ministry of Home Affairs. The police personnel of Delhi Police are paid their salary, allowances, etc. from the budget of Ministry of Home Affairs. Their leave and other rules are governed either by various rules framed under the Delhi Police Act or instructions issued by Government of India from time to time. Its employees upto the rank of Inspectors are governed under the Delhi Police Act 1980.

3. As regards points 2,3,4,5,6 & 7 : The information sought by you is not available with this public authority. However, your RTI application is being transferred to Delhi Police u/s 6(3) of RTI act, 2005 for replying the relevant point.
