

GOVERNMENT OF BOMBAY TO DISCHARGE THE FUNCTIONS OF THE CENTRAL GOVERNMENT UNDER SECTION 47 OF THE BOMBAY COURT OF WARDS ACT, 1905 IN RELATION TO THE ESTATE OF THE RULER OF AUNDH.

S. R. O. 1676, dated the 29th October, 1951.—In pursuance of the provisions of clause (1) of article 258 of the Constitution, the President, with the consent of the Government of Bombay, is pleased to entrust to that Government, in relation to the Estate of the Ruler of Aundh, the powers and functions conferred on the Central Government by section 47 of the Bombay Court of Wards Act, 1905 (Bombay Act 1 of 1905).
