S. R. O. 1761, dated the 7th November, 1951.—In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of article 243 of the Constitution, the President hereby directs that the Chief Commissioner, Andaman and Nicobar Islands, shall, subject to the control of the President, exercise all the powers of a State Government under the following enactments, namely:—

- (1) The Wild Birds and Animals Protection Act, 1912 (VIII of 1912).
- (2) The Indian Forests Act, 1927 (XVI of 1927).
