CHIEF COMMISSIONER OF VINDHYA PRADESH TO DISCHARGE CERTAIN FUNCTIONS OF THE CENTRAL GOVERNMENT UNDER THE MINIMUM WAGES ACT, 1948, IN RESPECT OF EMPLOYEES EMPLOYED IN STONE BREAKING OR STONE CRUSHING IN MINES AND QUARRIES WITHIN THE STATE.

S.R.O. 2053, dated the 11th December, 1951.—In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution, the President hereby directs that the Chief Commissioner of Vindhya Pradesh shall, subject to the control of the President and until further orders, discharge the functions of the Central Government under the Minimum Wages Act, 1948 (XI of 1948) in so far as these functions relate to—

- (a) the fixation under section 3 of the said Act of minimum rates of wages, and
- (b) the appointment under section 20 of the said Act of the Authority to hear and decide all claims arising out of payment of less than the minimum rates of wages,

in respect of employees employed in stone breaking or stone crushing carried on in mines and quarries within the State of Vindhya Pradesh.
