

Gurdwara Elections, with effect from 18-11-2009 on the following terms and conditions:-

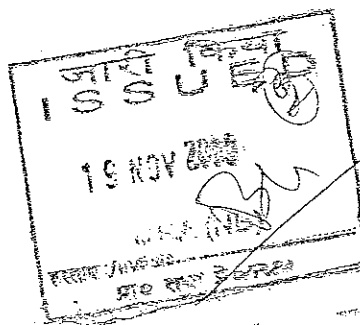
- (i) The post carries pay of Rs.80,000/- (fixed) minus pension.
