2. As per the provisions of the *Swatantrata Sainik Samman* Pension Scheme, 1980, an applicant is required to send his/her application through the concerned State Government. This is a mandatory requirement in view of the fact that the documents and evidence apropos claims are in possession of the concerned State Government and not of the Central Government. However, your application is being sent to the state government for necessary action in the matter.
