




Subject: - Transfer of application of Shri Tapan Ray under RTI Act, 2005.

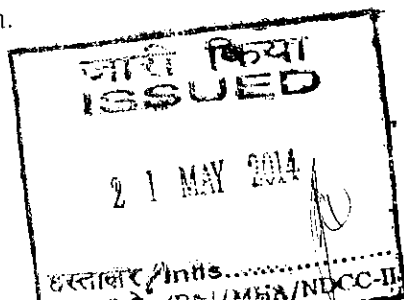
