¹S. R. O. 283, dated the 29th February, 1952.—In pursuance of article 239 of the Constitution, the President hereby directs as follows:—

Where any powers and functions which immediately before the 1st day of March, 1952 were the powers and functions of the Chief Commissioner of the State of Vindhya Pradesh or of the State of Himachal Pradesh by virtue of any order made under the said article, such powers and functions shall, on and after the said date, be exercised and discharged by the Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Vindhya Pradesh or, as the case may be, the Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Himachal Pradesh subject to the like control by the President as was exercisable by him over the Chief Commissioner.
