O. 742, dated the 23rd April, 1952.—In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution, the President hereby directs that the Chief Commissioner of Manipur shall, subject to the control of the President and until further orders exercise the powers and discharge the functions of the State Government under the provisions of section 5 of the Public Gambling Act, 1867 (III of 1867), as extended to the State of Manipur.
