(e) How many cases are running of domestic violence (CRPC 125) against how many IPS officers, IAS officers and PCS officers and How many cases are completed?	
(f) If in districts – Ludhiana, Jalandhar, Patiala, Chandigarh, criminal cases against dowry act are running pending then please provide the copy of all cases and also provide a list of names of IPS, IAS, PCS officers.
