

LIEUTENANT-GOVERNORS AND CHIEF COMMISSIONERS OF PART C STATES
TO EXERCISE POWERS AND DISCHARGE FUNCTIONS OF STATE GOVERN-
MENT UNDER SECTION 6 OF THE CRIMINAL LAW AMENDMENT ACT, 1952.

S.R.O. 1546, dated the 5th September, 1952.—In pursuance of
clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution, the President hereby
directs that the Chief Commissioners or Lieutenant-Governors, as the
case may be, of Part C States shall, subject to the control of the
President and until further orders, exercise the powers and discharge
the functions of the State Government under section 6 of the Criminal
Law Amendment Act, 1952 (Act XLVI of 1952).
