As such, Delhi Police falls directly under the control of Ministry of Home Affairs. The Police personnel of Delhi Police are paid their salary, allowances, etc. from the budget of Ministry of Home Affairs. Their leave and other rules are governed either by various rules framed under the Delhi Police Act or instructions issued by Government of India from time to time. Its employees upto the rank of Inspectors are governed under the Delhi Police Act 1980.
- 3. As regards points 2&3: This is beyond the definition of 'information' as defined u/s 2(f) of RTI Act 2005.
