

CHIEF COMMISSIONER, ANDAMAN AND NICOBAR ISLANDS TO EXERCISE THE  
POWERS OF A STATE GOVERNMENT UNDER THE PRISONS ACT, 1894.

S. R. O. 2051, dated the 11th December, 1952.—In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of article 243 of the Constitution, the President hereby directs that the Chief Commissioner, Andaman and Nicobar Islands, shall, subject to the control of the President, exercise the powers of a State Government under the Prisons Act, 1894 (IX of 1894).
