

CHIEF COMMISSIONER OF DELHI TO EXERCISE POWERS AND DISCHARGE
FUNCTIONS OF THE CENTRAL GOVERNMENT UNDER THE POWER ALCOHOL
ACT, 1948.

S.R.O. 293, dated the 7th February, 1953.—In pursuance of clause
(1) of article 239 of the Constitution, the President hereby directs that
the Chief Commissioner of Delhi shall, subject to the control of the
President and until further orders, exercise the powers and discharge
the functions of the Central Government under the provisions of the
Indian Power Alcohol Act, 1948 (XXII of 1948) in the State of Delhi.
