

CHIEF COMMISSIONER OF DELHI TO EXERCISE POWERS AND DISCHARGE  
FUNCTIONS OF CENTRAL GOVERNMENT UNDER THE MINIMUM WAGES  
ACT, 1948, RELATING TO EMPLOYEES OF THE DELHI TRANSPORT  
SERVICE.

(B) S.R.O. 779, dated the 21st April, 1953.—In pursuance of clause (1)  
of article 239 of the Constitution, the President hereby directs that  
the Chief Commissioner of Delhi shall, subject to the control of the  
President and until further orders, exercise the powers and discharge  
the functions of the Central Government under the Minimum Wages  
Act, 1948 (XI of 1948), relating to the employees employed in the  
Delhi Transport Service, Delhi.
