CHIEF COMMISSIONER OF BHOPAL TO EXERCISE POWERS AND DISCHARGE FUNCTIONS OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT UNDER THE BHOPAL ABOLITION OF JAGIRS AND LAND REFORMS ACT, 1953.

S.R.O. 1859, dated the 1st October, 1953.—In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution, the President hereby directs that the Chief Commissioner of Bhopal shall exercise the powers and discharge the functions of the State Government under the Bhopal Abolition of Jagirs and Land Reforms Act, 1953.
