

CHIEF COMMISSIONER OF DELHI TO EXERCISE POWERS OF STATE GOVERNMENT UNDER SECTION 3 (10) (d) OF THE GENERAL CLAUSES ACT, 1897 AND TO ACT AS CHIEF CONTROLLING REVENUE AUTHORITY FOR MATTERS OTHER THAN THOSE SPECIFIED IN LIST I OF THE SEVENTH SCHEDULE TO THE CONSTITUTION.

S.R.O. 2128, dated the 12th November, 1953.—In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution, the President, hereby directs that the Chief Commissioner of Delhi shall, subject to the control of the Central Government and until further orders, exercise the powers of the State Government under sub-clause (d) of clause (10) of section 3 of the General Clauses Act, 1897 (Act X of 1897), to appoint for the State of Delhi the Chief Controlling Revenue Authority or the Chief Revenue Authority in relation to matters other than those specified in List I in the Seventh Schedule to the Constitution.
