

CHIEF COMMISSIONER, ANDAMAN AND NICOBAR ISLANDS TO DISCHARGE  
THE FUNCTIONS AND EXERCISE THE POWERS OF A STATE GOVERNMENT  
UNDER THE INDIAN ELECTRICITY ACT, 1910 AND THE RULES MADE  
THEREUNDER EXCEPT UNDER CERTAIN SECTIONS, CLAUSES AND RULES.

S. R. O. 2322, dated the 19th December, 1953.—In pursuance of  
clause (1) of article 243 of the Constitution of India the President  
hereby directs that the Chief Commissioner of the Andaman and  
Nicobar Islands shall discharge within the said Islands all the functions  
and powers of the State Government under the Indian Electricity Act,  
1910 (IX of 1910), and the rules made thereunder, except under the  
following sections, clauses and rules, namely:—

Sections 13, 34, 36 and 55.

Clauses V(2) and XIII of the Schedule.

Rules 4, 6, 117 and 118.
