

CHIEF COMMISSIONER, AND AMAN AND NICOBAR ISLANDS TO EXERCISE THE POWERS AND DISCHARGE THE FUNCTIONS OF THE CENTRAL GOVERNMENT UNDER THE LAND ACQUISITION ACT, 1894.

S. R. O. 167, dated the 12th January, 1954.—In pursuance of clause (1) of article 243 of the Constitution, the President hereby directs that the Chief Commissioner, Andaman and Nicobar Islands, shall, subject to the control of the President, exercise the powers and discharge the functions of the Central Government under the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 (I of 1894).
