<sup>1</sup>S.R.O. 338, dated the 20th January, 1954.—In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution and in supersession of the notification of the Government of India in the late Department of Communications No. R-60, dated the 28th June, 1939, the President hereby directs that the Chief Commissioners of Delhi, Ajmer and Coorg shall, subject to the control of the President and until further orders, exercise the powers and discharge the functions of the State Government under the Motor Vehicles Act, 1939 (IV of 1939) within their respective States.
