CHIEF COMMISSIONERS OF DELHI, AJMER AND COORG TO EXERCISE POWERS OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT UNDER SECTION 2 OF THE CRIMINAL LAW AMENDMENT ACT, 1938.



S.R.O. 2416, dated the 20th July, 1954.—In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution, the President hereby directs that the Chief Commissioners of Delhi, Ajmer and Coorg shall, subject to the control of the Central Government and until further orders, exercise the powers of the State Government under section 2 of the Criminal Law Amendment Act, 1938 (XX of 1938) in the States of Delhi, Ajmer and Coorg respectively.
