CHIEF COMMISSIONERS OF DELHI, AJMER AND COORG TO EXERCISE POWERS  
AND DISCHARGE FUNCTIONS OF THE CENTRAL GOVERNMENT UNDER THE  
LAND ACQUISITION ACT, 1894.

S.R.O. 2751, dated the 19th August, 1954.—In pursuance of clause  
(1) of article 239 of the Constitution, the President hereby directs that  
the Chief Commissioners of Delhi, Ajmer and Coorg shall, subject to  
the control of the President and until further orders, exercise the  
powers and discharge the functions of the Central Government under  
the provisions of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 (I of 1894), within  
their respective States.
