CHIEF COMMISSIONER OF KUTCH TO EXERCISE POWERS AND DISCHARGE FUNCTIONS OF STATE GOVERNMENT UNDER THE ROAD TRANSPORT CORPORATIONS ACT, 1950.

S.R.O. 3138, dated the 22nd September, 1954.—In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution of India, the President is pleased to direct that the Chief Commissioner of Kutch shall, subject to the control of the President and until further orders, exercise powers and discharge the functions of a State Government under the provisions of the Road Transport Corporations Act, 1950 (LXIV of 1950), in the State of Kutch.
