

CHIEF COMMISSIONER OF AJMER TO PERFORM FUNCTIONS OF STATE
GOVERNMENT UNDER THE INDUSTRIAL EMPLOYMENT (STANDING
ORDERS) ACT, 1946.

S.R.O. 3227, dated the 9th October, 1954.—In exercise of the powers conferred by article 239 of the Constitution, the President hereby directs that, subject to his control and until further orders the Chief Commissioner of the State of Ajmer shall exercise the powers and discharge the functions of the State Government under the Industrial Employment (Standing Orders) Act, 1946 (XX of 1946), in the said State.
